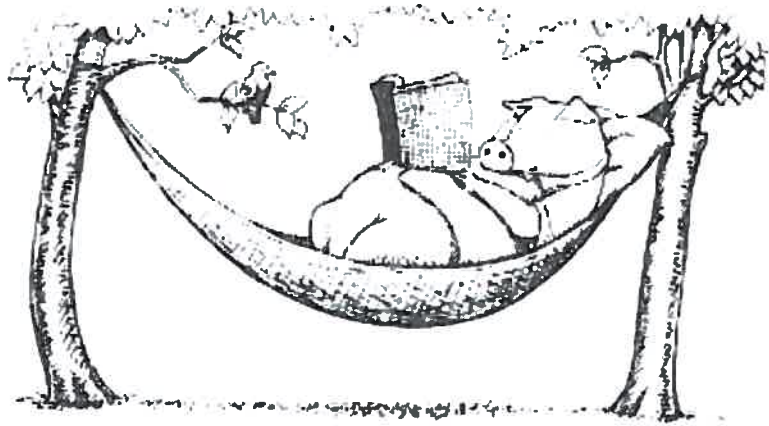

The complete library list is available in print or online at www.startingpointsforme.org.

You may borrow two materials at a time. You are responsible for the cost of return postage.

Materials will be mailed out on the day you request them if they are available.

Materials are loaned for a three-week period. If you need to renew them, call to check with us, we may be able to extend the due date as long as there is not a waiting list for the material.

If materials are more than two weeks late we will ask you for a **\$5 late fee donation**, payable to the MPF Library for every week the material is overdue. A reminder card will be mailed during the first week that materials are overdue.

We keep a waiting list for materials that are already on loan when you request them. You can ask that your name be added to the waiting list and materials will be mailed to you as soon as they become available.

About the Library List

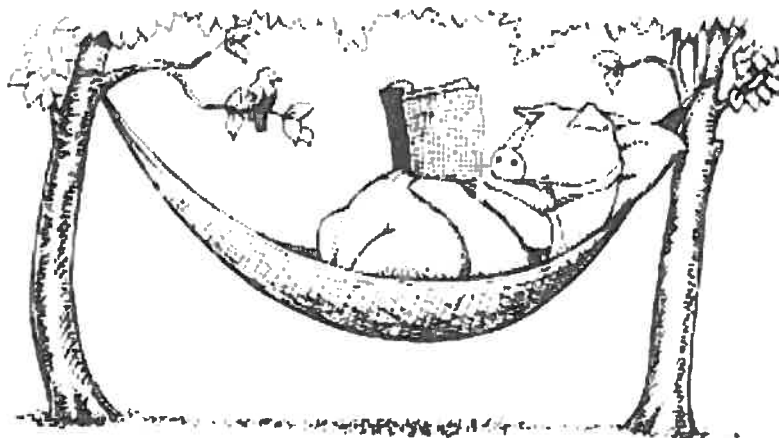
The library list is arranged by topic then listed alphabetically by title. Materials are not cross-referenced, so each title appears only once and you may have to check other sections.

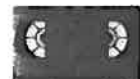

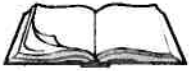
